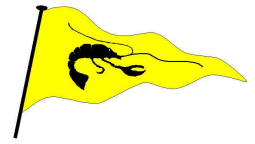

## Notice of Race

### River Hamble Combined Clubs Invitation Yacht Races

### Warsash Thursday Pursuit Race 16<sup>th</sup> July 2009

#### 1. Organising Authority

Warsash Sailing Club.

#### 2. Rules

Racing will be held under the Racing Rules of Sailing and the RYA Racing Charter. This Notice of Race may be varied by amendment or by the Sailing Instructions.

#### 3. Eligibility

This event is open to any member of an RYA affiliated Yacht Club.

#### 4. Classes

This race is organised for keel boats and will consist of two classes, the classes will be emailed to competitors and displayed on the WSC notice board by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2009.

#### 5. Handicaps

WSC ratings will be determined for all entries by the WSC Sailing Committee.

#### 6. Race Area and Start Times

Races will start at a line between the WSC Committee Boat and Bald Head Buoy. Start times will be determined from the WSC rating and shall be emailed to all competitors and displayed on the WSC notice board and web site by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July. The start sequence will commence at 18:40, with the first yachts starting at 18:45. The race will finish in the river at pile 10 with a time cut off at 20:15.

#### 7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be emailed to all competitors with their start time and will also be available on the WSC web site.

#### 8. VHF

All competing boats shall carry a working VHF radio with channels 6, 12, 16, 67, 72 and M1 (37).

#### 9. Entry

Entry forms are available from WSC and Hamble River Sailing Club websites. Entry costs £3 for the Thursday Pursuit or £5 for both the Thursday Pursuit Race and Hamble River Sailing Club's Wednesday Race on the 15<sup>th</sup> July. WSC Thursday Pursuit boats may enter this Race without payment but will not qualify for prizes.

#### 10. Conditions of entry

A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race, SIs or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching or going to sea, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least 2 million per event.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the racing and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, committee boat(s), the race officers and others.

#### 11. Results & Prize giving

The prize giving for the race will take place at WSC Clubhouse after racing that evening, the bar will be open and food will be available.
