**Declaration:** I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and all other rules that govern this event. In particular I have read the section of the Notice of Race covering the risk statement, and agree to the statements contained in it.

**Risk Statement:** Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue to race/participate is hers alone" and that sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- The provision of a race management team, patrol boats if any and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- The provision of patrol boat cover if any is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can practically be provided in the circumstances;
- Personal buoyancy shall be worn by all competitors whilst afloat;
- Their boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular, to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £3,000,000.

The information you provide in this form will be used solely for dealing with you as a temporary member of WSC. WSC has its own data protection policies. Your data will be stored and used in accordance with these policies. It will be destroyed when the event is completed, unless the law requires it to be further retained (e.g. for accounts). Please raise any queries concerning this policy with the Hon Sec. The Policy details how personal data is processed to enable the Club to perform its contracts with

members and temporary members concerning participation in WSC events. Data is retained for the legitimate interests of WSC in operating a sailing event. The Club may arrange for photographs or videos of racing and other activities, these may be published on the Club website or social media.
